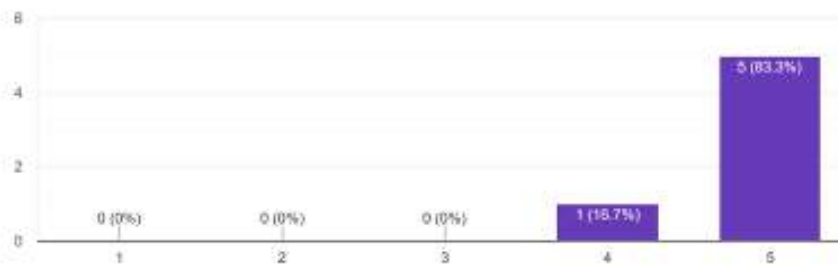

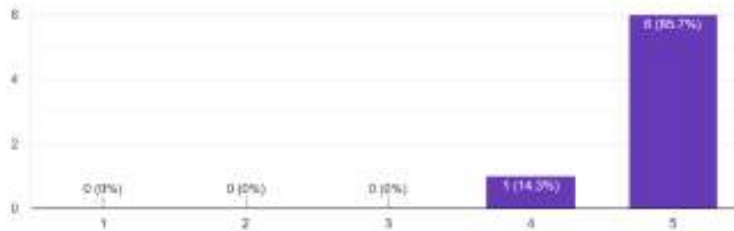

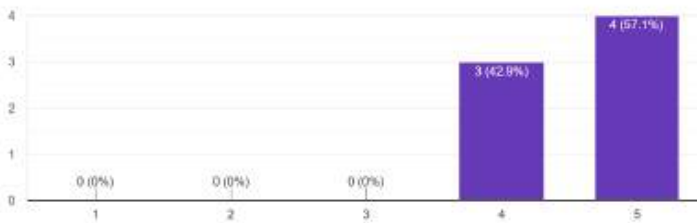

Competitors use a powerful, precise technique involving a glide or spin to achieve maximum distance, with the longest valid throw winning.

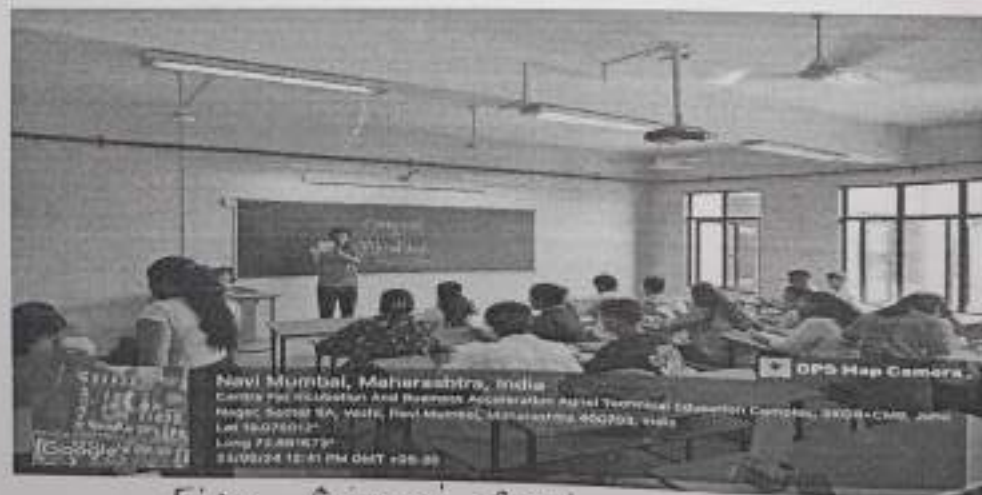


Fig.2 Origami Session





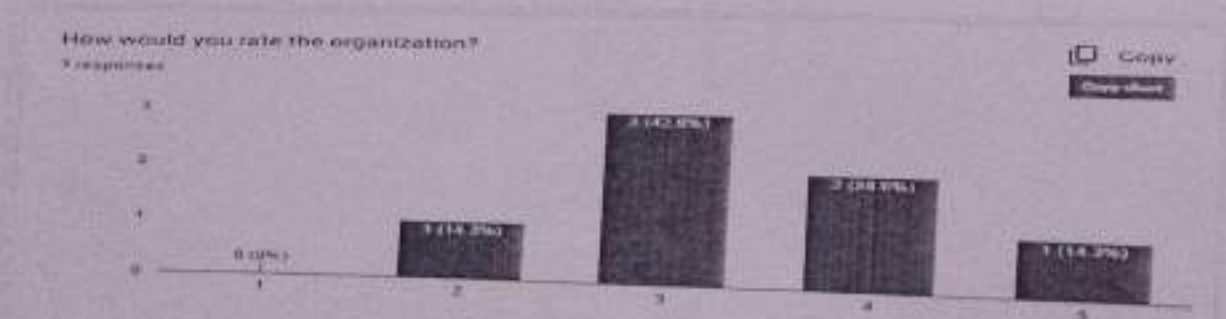
