

- b. Description: Aperture controls light and depth of field; ISO adjusts sensor sensitivity and noise; Shutter Speed affects exposure time and motion blur. Together, they form the Exposure Triangle, balancing light and image clarity. Adjust one to manage exposure, and compensate with the others for desired results.


Fig. 1 Attendance
