If a student subsequently loses eligibility for the program with the larger tuition benefit their eligibility for the program with the smaller tuition benefit will be re-evaluated.
- Awards funded through external entities (outside grants, scholarships, fellowships, etc.) can be used in conjunction with University awards/discounts, however the combination of tuition benefits from all sources cannot exceed the student's cost of tuition. If the combination of awards exceeds the cost of tuition the University award/discount will be reduced to no longer exceed the cost of tuition. Exceptions may apply based on external agency policies.

- Failure to accept the scholarship will result in the withdrawal of the award.

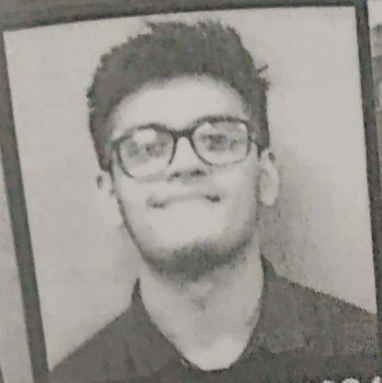
