

NSS FCRIT, program officer, Mr. Rahul Jadhav also contributed to personal funds of NSS Mumbai University's program officer's initiative for distribution of rashan in Aadivasi locality in Raigad district.





h. Technical Description


The response to the campaign was excellent and overwhelming. We received more than 80 entrees and were delighted by the hard work of people to spend their time in crafting handmade posters.
