
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#### NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS IN THE SURVEY

c. Outcomes:







a. Objectives: To conduct a blood donation camp.

b. Cultural Description: The NSS unit of FCRIT along with Agnel's Social Cell organized a Blood Donation Camp on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2020, in collaboration with Jaslok hospital. The event was conducted in Diploma Seminar Hall of Agnel's Polytechnic between 9 am to 5 pm ,on 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2022

The camp was available to all and any member of the institute who met the safety criteria was allowed to donate blood. A registration desk was set up in the entrance of the hall with NSS volunteers serving as receptionists, who guided the donators with the process of registration. Further, once the necessary paperwork was completed, the individual was tested for their blood pressure and blood group by the professionals from Jaslok Hospital.

An amount of 350ml of blood was donated by each donor and the process of blood collection was done in a very hygienic and precise manner. The syringes once used, were disposed off and the blood bags were arranged properly according to their blood type.

A total of **151 individuals**, staff and students included, participated in the blood donation camp and each volunteer was awarded a donor card as an appreciation of their goodwill. Moreover, to help with the dizziness that comes after donating blood, each volunteer was provided with liquid and solid refreshments.

At each stage of the event, volunteers of NSS and social cell were always present to help the event flow in ease. The blood donation camp was considered a huge success, as in its first installment, it attracted about 151 donors, many of them from rarer blood groups. The teams who organized this event wait eagerly to lend their efforts to another such success.

**c. Outcomes**: The camp was successful. The targeted number i.e 151 blood bags were collected. Students as well as faculty members participated in the camp.


