

#### 8. Brief Summary of the Activity/Event (in maximum 500 words):

- a. Objectives: To conduct a Health Check-up which included eye check-up, blood sugar test, bone density test and ECG. The aim was to understand the importance of eyes, blood sugar, bones and heart rate.
  - Eye check-up: -The eyes are among the most sensitive organs of the body and are considered to be one of the most important senses. Despite this, taking good care of our eyes is often ignored, resulting in many people losing their sight and needing glasses.
  - Blood Sugar Test: Blood sugar testing provides useful information for diabetes management. If someone has diabetes, self-testing their blood









sugar (blood glucose) can be an important tool in managing their diabetes and preventing complications.

- Bone density test: Bone density tests measure how strong the bones are. Health care providers use these tests to both screen for and diagnose osteoporosis. The tests are important, because they can alert you to problems with your bones before you have a fracture.
- ECG: it helps to help diagnose and monitor conditions affecting the heart.
- **b. Technical Description:** The NSS unit of Fr. C. Rodrigues Institute of Technology, Vashi organized a one-day Health Check-up. The event was held offline on September 15, 2022. The event was in collaboration with Fortis Hospital, Vashi. A registration form, poster, and promotional message were distributed to FCRIT's WhatsApp class groups and posted on our official Instagram handle. The promotion lasted only one day, on 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2022. The Health Check-up was attended by 220 people, including staff and students. With the aim to increase awareness among people, we kept free registration.

At each point of the event, members from our club were always present by sharing their contact number in the promotional message to help the event flow in ease. Students, Faculty Members as well as the college staff members were benefitted by this event. The team who organized this event are eagerly lending their efforts for the next event to make it a success.





#### 7. Brief Summary of the Event

#### 8. Brief Summary of the Event

- **a. Objectives:** The NSS unit of Fr. C. Rodrigues Institute Of Technology organized a blood donation camp in Fr. Conceicao Rodrigues Institute of Technology (FCRIT), Vashi. The camp was conducted in collaboration with MGM Hospital, Vashi. The main objective of this camp was to encourage voluntary blood donation among students, faculty, and staff members of FCRIT, as well as the local community.
- **b. Description:** The blood donation camp started at 9:00 AM and continued till 4:00 PM. The camp was set up in the college auditorium, where all the necessary arrangements were made, including beds, medical equipment, and refreshments for the donors. The MGM Hospital doctors and nurses, along with the FCRIT staff, were present to ensure the smooth running of the camp.

The donors were required to fill out a health questionnaire before donating blood. The questionnaire included questions about their medical history, recent travel, and current

health status. After filling out the form, the donors went through a preliminary medical examination to check their blood pressure, pulse rate, and hemoglobin levels. If the donor passed the initial examination, they were taken to the blood donation area where a pint of blood was collected.

c. Outcomes: A total of 153 people donated blood during the camp. The donors included students, faculty, and staff members of FCRIT, as well as local residents. The camp was successful in achieving its objectives of promoting voluntary blood donation and raising awareness about the importance of donating blood. The blood collected during the camp will be used for transfusions in MGM Hospital and other hospitals in the region.
